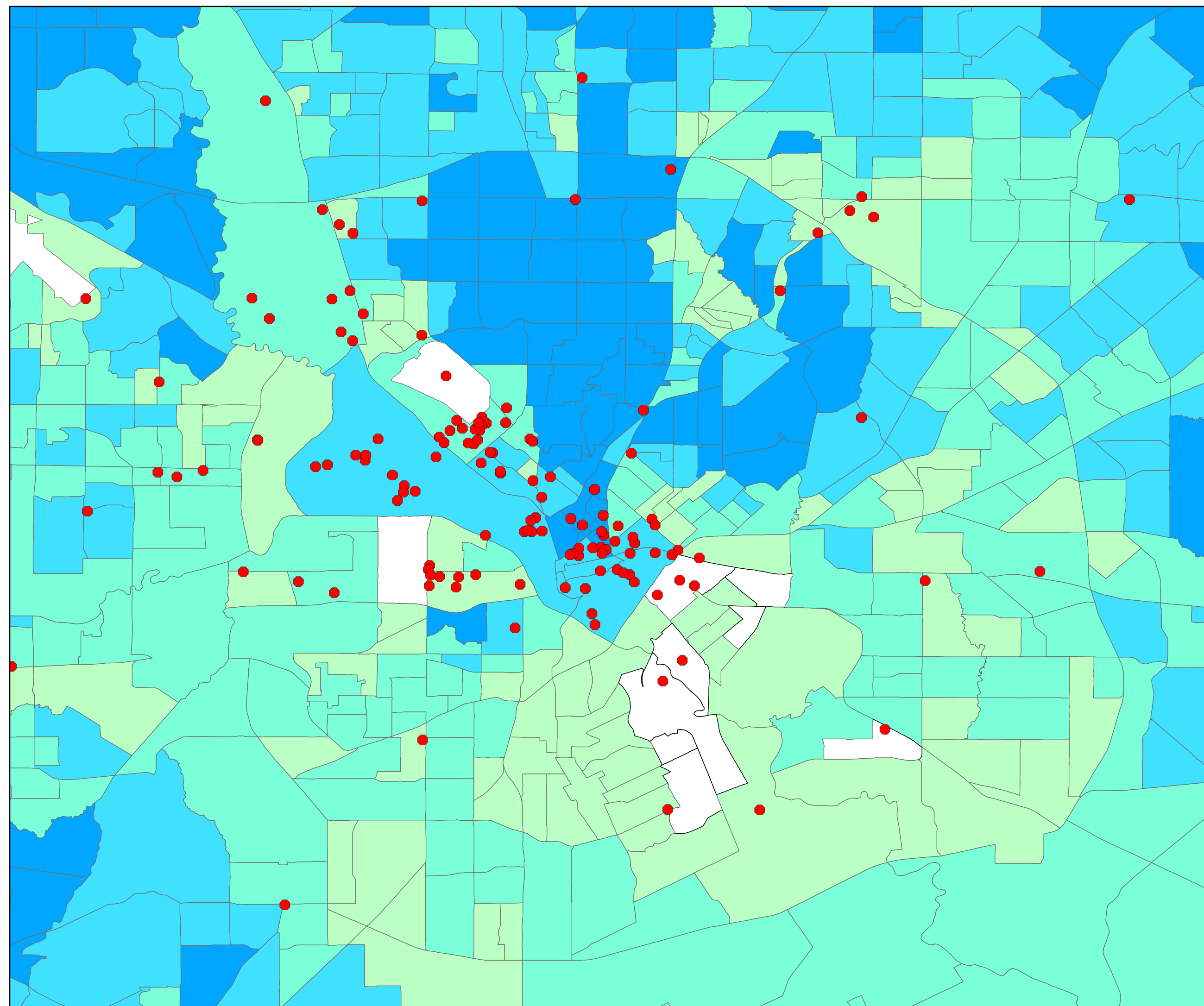


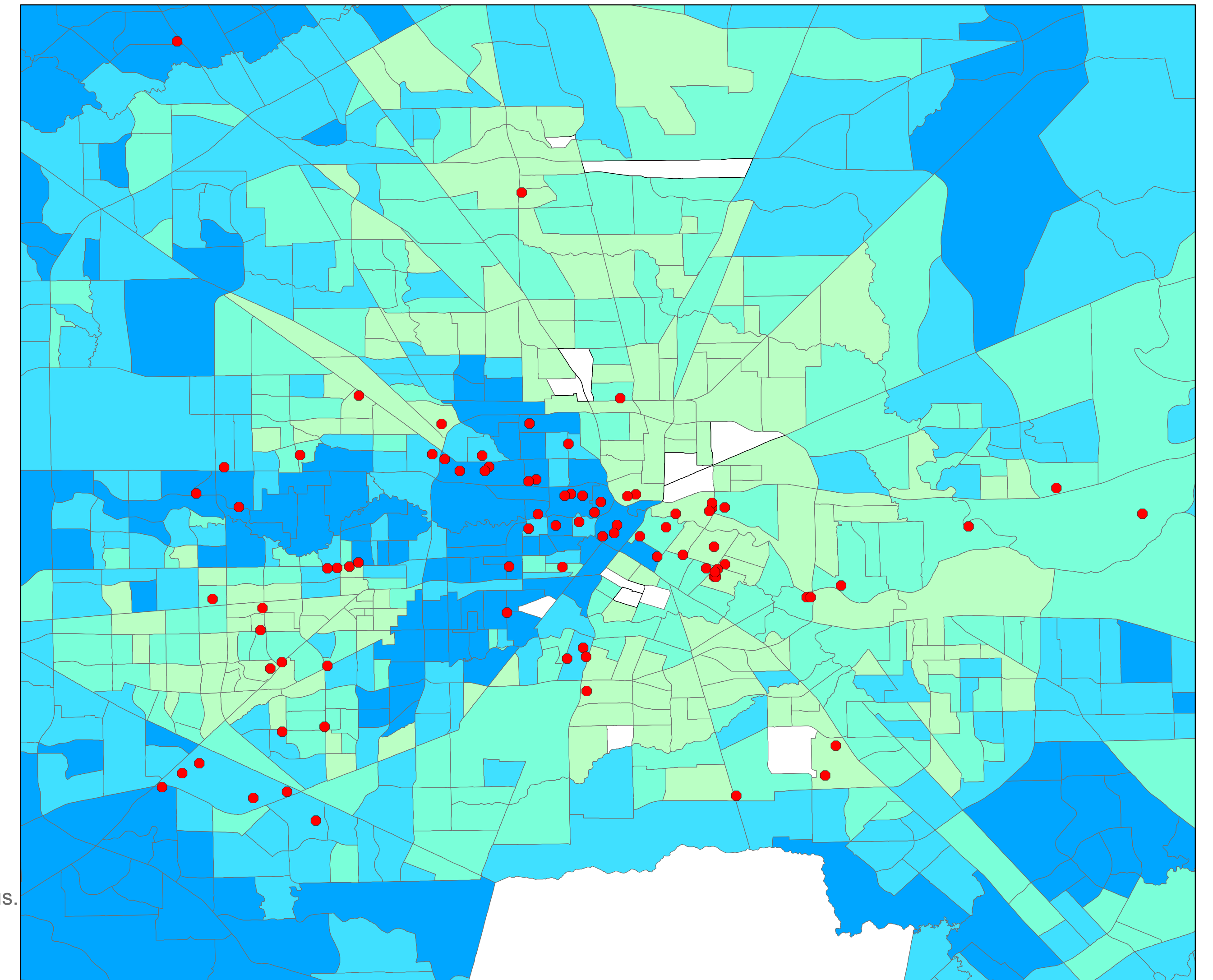
Municipal Setting Designations and Income

A Municipal Setting Designation, established by the Texas Legislature in September 1, 2003, is an official state designation for a property, which allows a responsible party to be exempted from groundwater cleanup requirements on a contaminated site. This poster explores the relationship between contaminated sites that the cities of Dallas and Houston have granted groundwater cleanup exemptions for, and the income of people in the area (by census tract).
